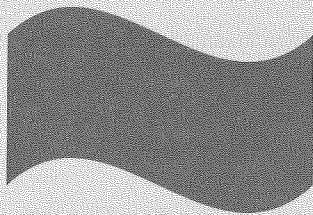

Member Profile-Community Caregivers

Mission- Community Caregivers, Inc. provides caregiving services that enable individuals of all ages to maintain their independence, dignity, and quality of life within their homes and communities.

Founded in 1994 in Altamont, Community Caregivers, Inc. is a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit corporation provides caregiving services to those in need, without charge, in the townships of Guilderland, Bethlehem, New Scotland, Knox and Berne in Albany County, New York. Our mission is to provide these services so that seniors, persons living with disabilities, and persons living in poverty are able to remain independent within their own homes with safety and dignity. Since 2005, 450 volunteers have assisted 600-plus clients with 22,000 direct services and have driven clients approximately 50,000 miles.

Services include transportation to doctors' offices, chemotherapy and dialysis treatments, physical therapy rehabilitation centers, adult day care facilities, etc.; respite care for family caregivers; light housekeeping; yard work; visitation; telephone assurance; shopping and running errands; and assistance in referrals to other agencies.

Volunteers are recruited, trained and coordinated by a small core agency staff. Our client intake coordinator is a registered nurse who makes an initial home visit assessment to each new client to assess their needs, develop referral services where appropriate, and start the services. In October 2011, we expanded our services to include one night and one weekend day.

Funding comes from our gala and golf events supported by local businesses, individual donations, foundations and government support. The entire annual budget is \$300,000.
