

Transportation Volunteer

Qualifications:

- A valid New York State Driver's License
- Proof of insurance
- DMV background check

Scope of work:

Driving disabled, elderly, and non-driving persons to and from medical/therapy appointments, visits to family in nursing homes and other essential activities. We provide rides to the city of Albany and the surrounding towns as far as Latham, and to the city of Schenectady. We do not provide rides to Troy or Scotia.

Responsibilities:

Escort client to and from destination in accordance with [volunteer driver guidelines](#).

Time required:

Transporting a client to Albany, Schenectady or Latham will take from 1 to 3 hours. If the client expects the appointment to be longer, Community Caregivers will assign two drivers (one for drop-off and one for pick-up).
